## Why?

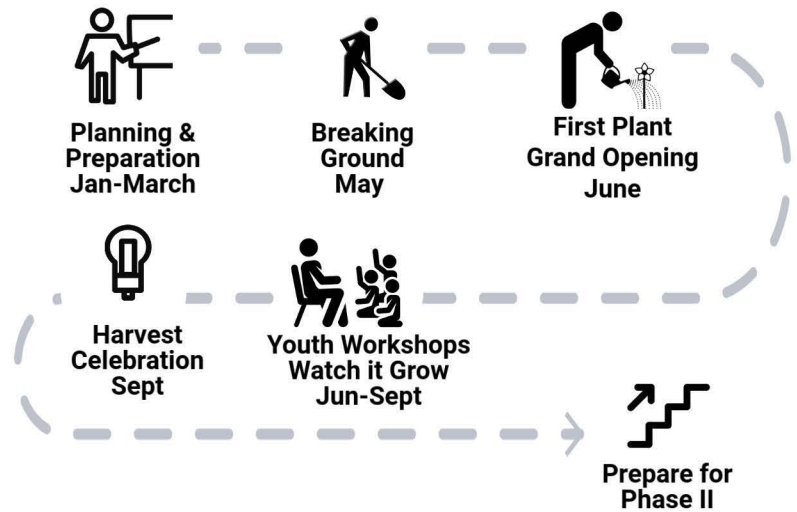

## Objectives

To empower the youth and families by addressing food insecurity, fostering personal growth, and creating opportunities for academic, emotional, and community development.

- ✓ Establish and maintain a community garden capable of producing fresh, healthy food to support 1,500 residents.
- ✓ Implement structured programming rooted in Positive Youth Development (PYD), arts enrichment, and social-emotional learning activities for at least 150 children annually.
- ✓ Promote healthier lifestyles and creating opportunities for residents to connect and grow together.
